



# Process for Amending Constitution and Bylaws

## **August 19**

DEADLINE for members, locals, councils, and the AFT-W Executive Board to propose changes to the Constitution and Bylaws. Submissions should be emailed to [kreul@aft-wisconsin.org](mailto:kreul@aft-wisconsin.org).

## **September 15**

The AFT-W Executive Board reviews all proposed amendments. The Board cannot alter submitted amendments, but may propose changes along with their recommendations to delegates.

## **September 19**

Proposed amendments will be emailed to local presidents and posted online at [aft-wisconsin.org](http://aft-wisconsin.org).

## **October 19 (first day of Convention)**

Constitution Committee proposes and votes on any changes before amendments go to the Delegate Assembly. This is the first time that changes can be made to the amendments.

## **October 23 (last day of Convention)**

Delegates debate and may amend proposed amendments. The Delegate Assembly votes by roll call vote (delegate strength). Constitutional amendments need a 2/3 vote to pass. Bylaws require a majority vote.
