AFT-Wisconsin Resolution on Member Communication Proposal for the AFT-Wisconsin Convention 2021

- Whereas, the AFT-Wisconsin Mission charges the organization “to bring together all members to assist and support one another and to promote democracy, human rights and freedom in our union, our state and our nation;” and
- Whereas, AFT-Wisconsin and our locals are often members’ first experiences working within the labor movement and building collective power; and
- Whereas, AFT-Wisconsin is strengthened by sharing the stories and action of members and locals, by inviting members to participate in the democratic structures of our union, and by building a collective movement; therefore be it
- Resolved, that AFT-Wisconsin will welcome new members into our state federation by collecting and sharing information about the constituencies and structures of the state federation, about the officers and staff of the state federation, about their constituency and regional vice presidents, and about our recent resolutions, events, and actions; and be it further
- Resolved, that AFT-Wisconsin will provide monthly updates to all members about recent collective actions of locals, about events hosted by the state federation, and about legislative issues of importance to the state federation; and be it further
- Resolved, that AFT-Wisconsin will include in these communications updates about recent decisions of the AFT-Wisconsin Executive Board and invitations to participate in upcoming meetings of the AFT-Wisconsin Executive Board and its committees; and be it finally
- Resolved, that AFT-Wisconsin locals will share our victories, our struggles, and our actions with the state federation so we may develop a stronger collective movement.
